REED LIBRARY IN 2021...



6,242individuals attended 642 programs, many virtually.

Over 27,000 items were loaned including books, music, museum passes, movies, and magazines.



There are 4,012 Reed Library card holders.

Our wireless network was signed into 4,021 times.



Over 53,000 digital and physical items are in our collection!



Library users downloaded OVER 10,000 eBooks, movies, music, and audio-books.



Storytimes provide early literacy and learning skills, essential for future school success.



Caring for the library building is an investment in our community's future. We want it to be here serving you for a long time to come. In 2021 we received a \$25,000 grant secured by Assemblyman Kevin Byrnes. The funding was used for a new sign and helped with the roof restoration.
